

## *PA- Supplemental Guidance*

**ANM-13 Non-forested riparian zone enhancement for fish and wildlife –**  
 Maintaining or enhancing an existing non-forested riparian zone. New plantings can be either herbaceous or woody vegetation. The minimum width of the enhanced riparian zone must be 35 feet wide or 2.5 times the width of the stream channel, whichever is greater to a maximum of 150 feet.

<b>Seeding</b>
Indiangrass – 3 lbs/ac PLS
Switchgrass – 2 lbs/ac PLS
Wildrye – 2 lbs/ac PLS
Maximillian sunflower – 1/4 lb/ac PLS
Black-eyed susan – 1/4 lb/ac PLS

**Seeding dates:** Southern PA – Dec. 1 to April 15  
 Northern PA – Nov. 15 to May 15

**Planting dates for trees or shrubs:** Southern PA – by May 1  
 Northern PA – by April 15
