


Changing Symbology in ArcMap

Abstract

This is a general guide for altering the symbol for any given layer in a project. For specific instructions on configuring symbology for different features in a layer, refer to that document instead.

Details

1. In the Table of Contents, under the layer name, **click** once on the existing symbol for the layer. This will bring up a *Symbol Selector* window where you can choose pre-formatted symbols or manually choose colors for fills, outlines, lines, or points.



2. **Click** once on the colored boxes on the right, for *Fill Color* or *Outline Color*, to see a color palette to choose from. Outline width will change the thickness of the outline. For linear layers, it will just be Color and Width. For point layers, it will just be Color and Size. Set the colors to your liking.
3. **Click OK** to apply your changes.
4. Save your project .
5. If symbology of *practice layers* has been changed, **right click** on the *practice layer* in the table of contents. Select **Save Symbolology** from the drop down menu.
