


Helpful Hint—Change the Appearance of Annotation Layer Callout Labels



Procedure:


1. Create a Planned Land Unit (PLU) layer and attribute it.
2. Click on the map label tool and select Callout for the label style.



3. If present, turn off any other annotation layers.
4. Go to Edit→Select All Elements. Note the dashed lines around each label.



5. Use the Drawing Toolbar at the bottom of the ArcMap screen to change the font, the color of the font, the size of the font, the fill color of the callout box, and the color of the line around the box.



The Drawing Toolbar can also be used to change the appearance of annotation labels created as Text or Bullet Leader.
